ALISON HAGERUP BEACH PARK - FREE PARKING

Captiva Erosion Prevention District is **waiving parking fees now through Sept. 10** at Alison Hagerup Beach Park, 14790 Captiva Drive, Captiva, FL. The fee waiver is consistent with the Town of Fort Myers Beach, Lee County Parks and Recreation, and the City of Sanibel, all of whom are waiving parking fees to assist businesses impacted by red tide.

Lee County Parks & Recreation has contracted with CrowderGulf to clean the beaches. Since last Friday, August 25, 2018, the Alison Hagerup Beach Park has been closed to the public, being utilized by Lee County as the necessary staging area for workers and equipment. They will be finished with their project by the end of business today, and the Park will again be open for visitors.

CEPD will continue to monitor the beach situation, and let you know once the fees will start again.
